

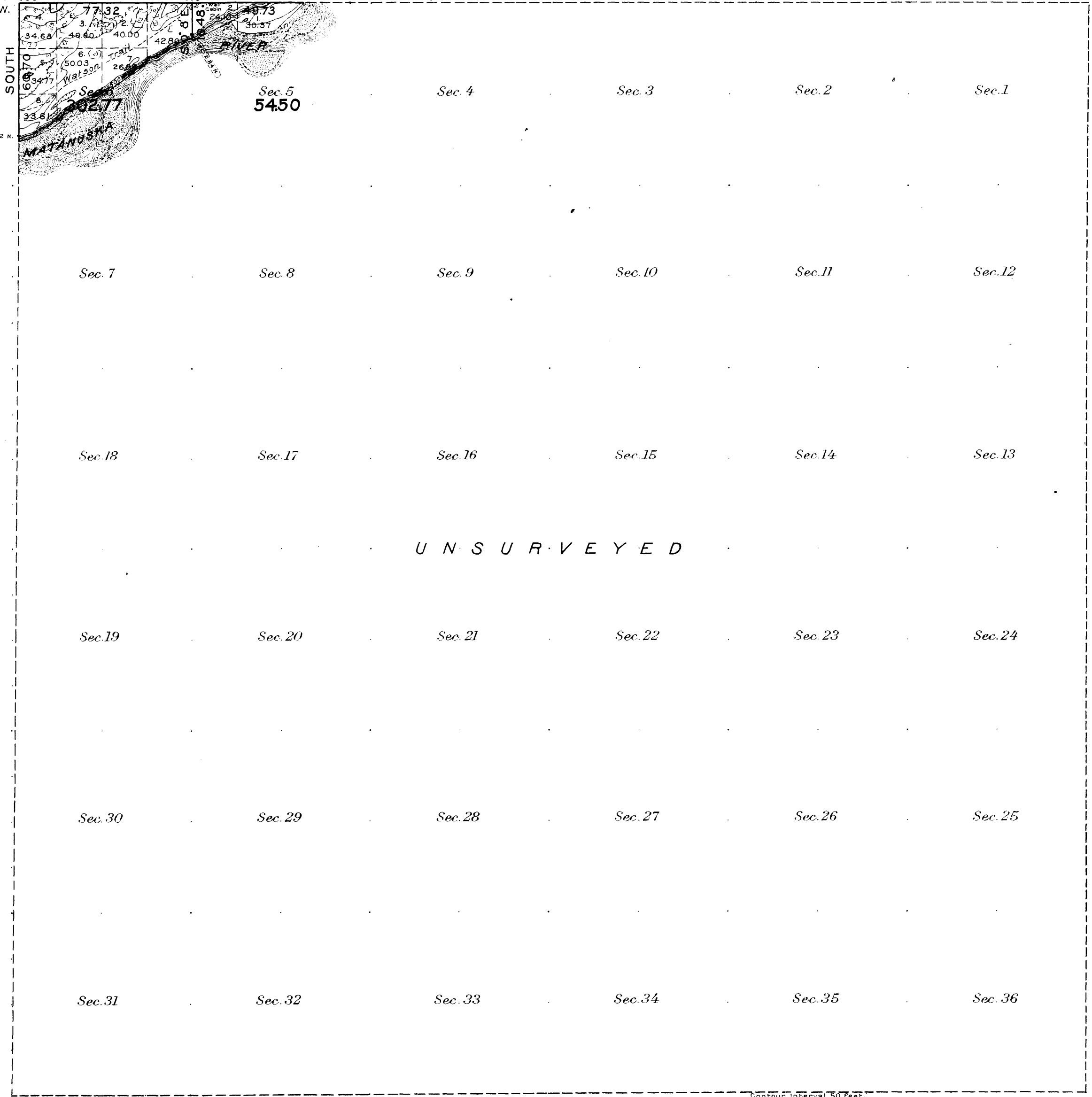

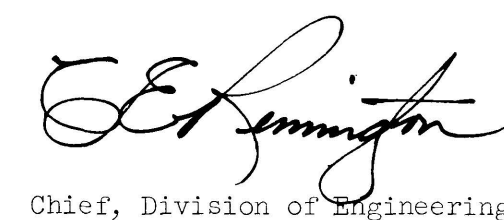

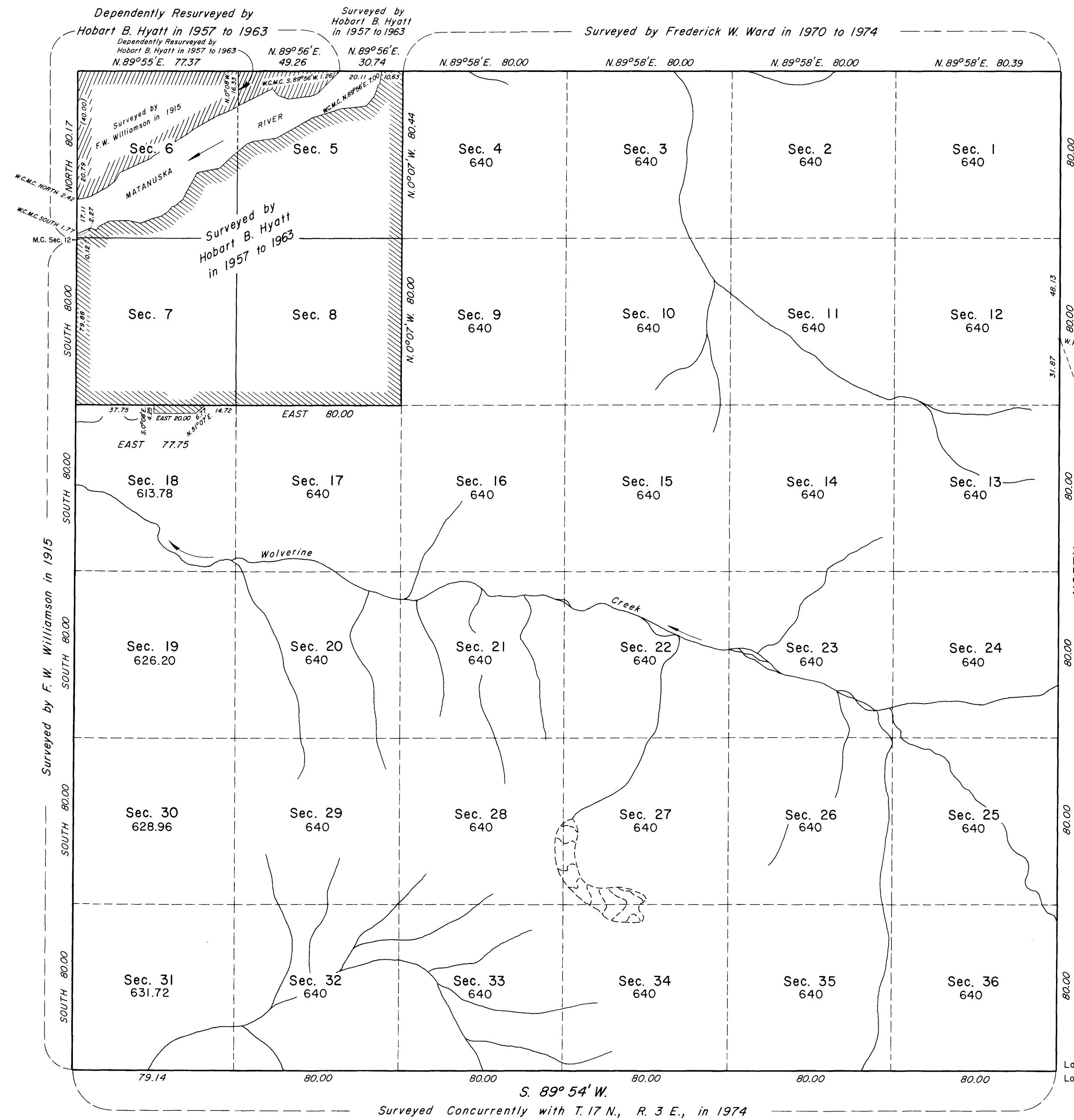

# TOWNSHIP 18 NORTH, RANGE 3 EAST, OF THE SEWARD MERIDIAN, ALASKA



A history of surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat represents the survey of the east boundary of T. 18 N., R. 3 E., Seward Meridian, Alaska, executed by Frederick W. Ward, Cadastral Surveyor, July 15, 1974 through October 17, 1974, under Special Instructions dated March 7, 1974, and Amended Special Instructions dated July 22, 1974, for Group No. 177, Alaska.

Portions of this township were protracted based upon the record of the surveyed lines and the official protraction diagram.

The hydrography shown on this plat was obtained from U.S. Geological Survey quadrangle maps "Anchorage (C-5) and (C-6)," Alaska, dated 1960 and 1951 with minor revisions in 1962, respectively, and measurements to topographic features.

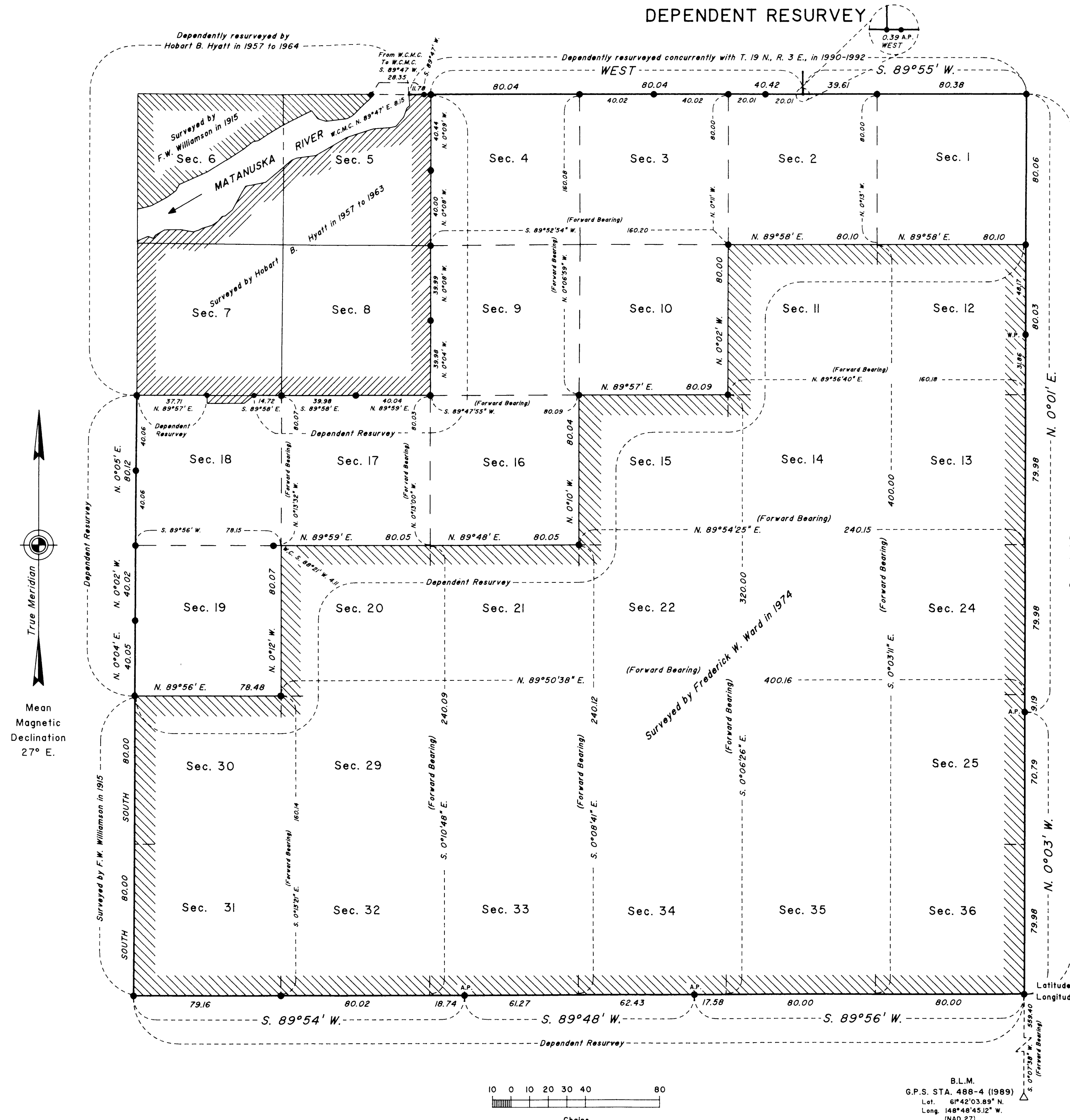

## DEPENDENT RESURVEY



The history of the surveys is contained in the field notes.

This plat and the field notes represent the dependent resurvey of the south boundary, the east boundary, a portion of the west boundary, portions of the subdivisional lines, and a portion of the subdivisional lines surveyed by protraction of Township 18 North, Range 3 East, Seward Meridian, Alaska. A portion of the subdivisional lines of this township were surveyed by protraction in 1974 under Group No. 177, Alaska.

This survey was executed by Peter R. Nanok, Cadastral Surveyor, May 14 through June 30, 1990, in accordance with the specifications set forth in the Manual of Surveying Instructions, 1973, Special Instructions for Group No. 488, Alaska, dated April 19, 1990, approved May 7, 1990, Assignment Instructions dated May 17, 1990.

Except as indicated hereon, areas and lottings are as shown on the plat of Township 18 North, Range 3 East, Seward Meridian, Alaska, accepted October 17, 1979; the plat of Township 18 North, Range 3 East, Seward Meridian, Alaska, accepted June 8, 1964; the plat of Township 18 North, Range 3 East, Seward Meridian, Alaska, accepted April 13, 1916; and U.S. Survey No. 9077 accepted September 27, 1995.

The hydrography shown on this plat was obtained from the best available U.S. Geological Survey quadrangle maps.

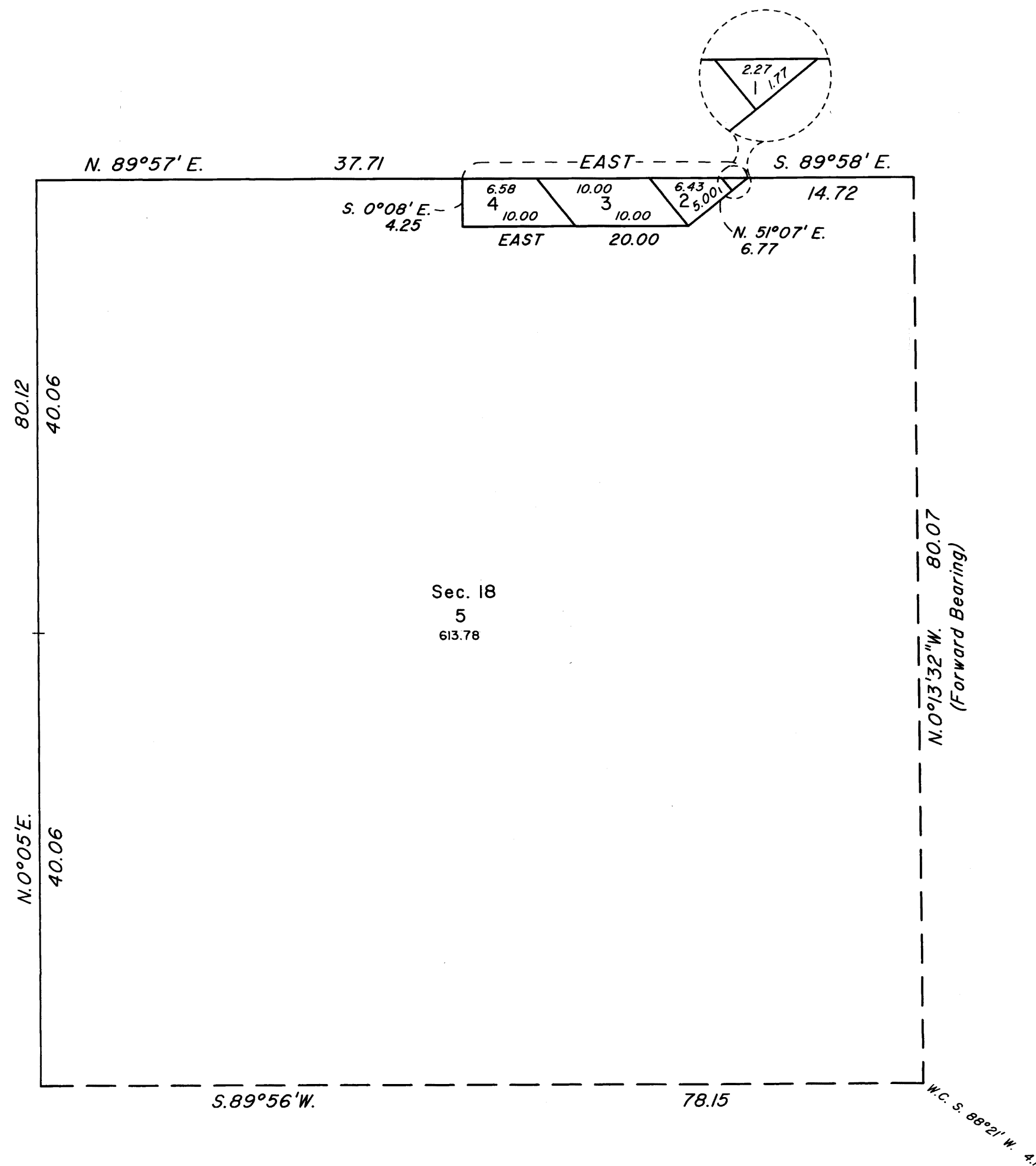
This plat amends lotting in Sec. 18, T. 18 N., R. 3 E., S.M., Alaska, creating lot 5.
