

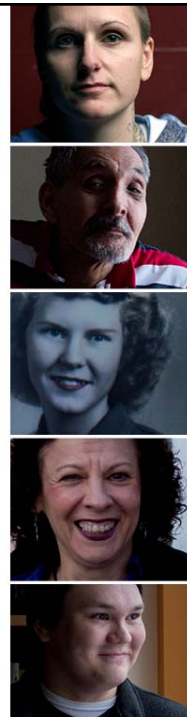
Home and Community Based Services Reform Update

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Project Background

- January 2015
 - Trustee’s approved funding for 1915 (k)/(i) contract
- August 2015
 - AK team attended National HCBS Conference
- September 2015
 - Contract awarded to Health Management Associates
- October 2015
 - Stakeholder engagement and ICC council formation
- January 2016
 - Recommended Medicaid Redesign + Expansion Strategies for AK report released
- March 2016
 - Engaged HCB Strategies to assist with providing TA for implementing new Assessment Tool
- June 21, 2016
 - SB74 signed into law
- August 2016
 - HMA final report submitted to SDS
- FY 2018
 - Begin reform implementation
