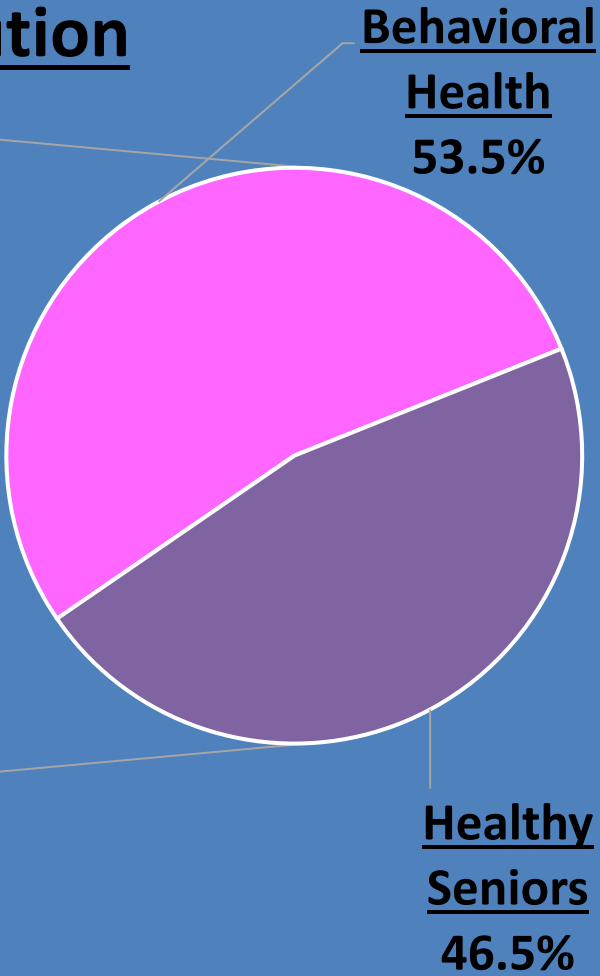
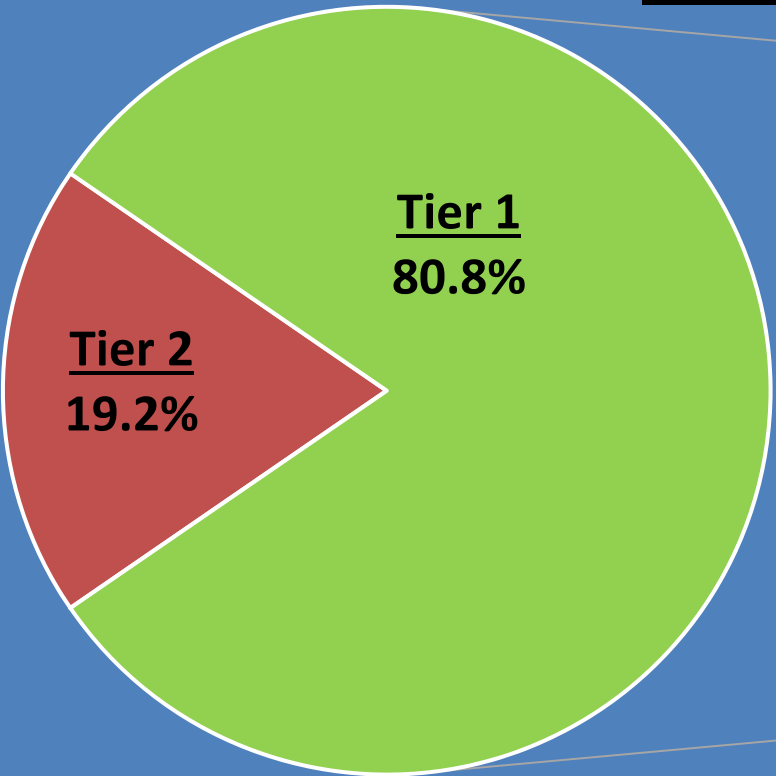
MSHF Funding Parameters
