Beneficiaries include Alaskans who experience mental illness, substance use disorders, developmental disabilities, Alzheimer’s Disease or related dementia, and traumatic brain injuries.

Each fiscal year, trustees approve funding for grants to beneficiaries, nonprofit organizations, service providers, tribal entities, state and local government agencies, and other groups that serve Trust beneficiaries.
