

TOWNSHIP 8 SOUTH, RANGE 13 WEST, OF THE SEWARD MERIDIAN, ALASKA

The south boundary (Second Standard Parallel South) was surveyed concurrently with Tps. 9 S., Rs. 13 and 14 W., under Group No. 136, Alaska. The east boundary (Third Guide Meridian West) was surveyed concurrently with T. 8 S., R. 12 W., of this group.

This plat represents the survey of the west and north boundaries of T. 8 S., R. 13 W., Seward Meridian, executed by Frederick W. Ward, Supervisory Cadastral Surveyor, July 23, 1964, through September 29, 1965, under Special Instructions dated July 13, 1964, for Group No. 159, Alaska.

The net area shown hereon, being exclusive of the U.S. Surveys and mineral surveys, and the waters of Kachemak, Kasitsna, and Tutka Bays, but inclusive of any islands in place therein, which were in existence at the time of survey, has been designated Tract "A" for legal description purposes.

AMENDED PLAT



This amended plat of Township 8 South, Range 13 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska, revises the hydrography based upon the dependent resurvey and subdivision of U.S. Survey No. 4750 and the survey of U.S. Survey Nos. 6872, 8628, 8730, and 8793; segregates the areas of U.S. Survey Nos. 6872, 8628, 8730, and 8793 from original Tract A; revises the platted position and adjusts the area previously segregated by U.S. Survey No. 4740 based upon the retracement shown on the plat of U.S. Survey No. 8793. These revisions creating Tract B are based upon the dependent resurvey and subdivision of U.S. Survey No. 4750 and the survey of U.S. Survey Nos. 6872, 8628, 8730, and 8793; the plat of Township 8 South, Range 13 West, Seward Meridian, Alaska, accepted August 30, 1977; the plat of the dependent resurvey of U.S. Survey No. 4750 accepted November 2, 1988; the plat of U.S. Survey No. 6872 accepted July 18, 1983; the plat of U.S. Survey No. 8628 accepted August 30, 1988; the plat of U.S. Survey No. 8730 accepted October 27, 1988; and the plat of U.S. Survey No. 8793 accepted October 6, 1989.

Acceptance of this survey does not purport to transfer any interest in submerged lands to which the State of Alaska is entitled under the Equal Footing Doctrine and Section 6(m) of the Alaska Statehood Act, P.L. 85-508, notwithstanding the use, location, or absence of meander lines to depict water bodies.
