





# **Budget Recommendations**

General Observations: Is there inequity in the distribution of Trust funding among its statutory required beneficiaries?

#### For example:

- Of 34 "Partnership Grants" totally \$4,448,903 reviewed and recommended by the P&P committee 5 are related to the I/DD population (\$137,263/3%). \$0 for ADRD, and \$88,000 for TBI.
- oFY 27 proposed budget of just over \$42 million, 28% spent on TLO/PLO operations with vast majority of the rest spent on MH and SUD beneficiaries, with IDD, ADRD and TBI far below.



# GCDSE Staffing # 1 Priority

- Experienced team of 7 staff;
- Proposed by Trust staff: \$225,000 for FY 27--slight increase (11%)
- Proposed by Council: Council needs the Trust to include us at \$375,000 for joint staffing SOI.
- Enough to keep all 3 Program Coordinator I/II positions next year.
- OCompare to ABADA/AMHB, \$491.5 K for 2-4 positions
- Compare to ACOA, \$200 K for 2 positions




















# Project SEARCH Adult Site Proposal

Seeking \$75 K for Year 1 and \$40 K for Year 2 to create a "young adult" (ages 18-35) Project SEARCH site(s) for people who experience disabilities

 Location Anchorage or Juneau primary consideration, serve 6-12 persons per year

Built on success with our 3 current school-based "Youth" (ages 18-22) sites running, having served over 283 interns from 2010.

- Last 5 years have averaged 81.55% employment outcomes (that's even with COVID impacts!)
- Sites are high achieving and recognized by PS National awarded five 100% Outcome Awards and six 70-90% Outcome Awards in last 5 years.

- GCDSE (as Statewide Coordinator) works with Adult Education Partner, Community Rehab Provider, Division of Vocational Rehabilitation (DVR), Host Business, and Project SEARCH National Liaison to open these new sites no current "adult" program in Alaska so is a high need area.
- Applicants typically qualify for DVR funding supports, and some for Medicaid Supported Employment if on a
  waiver for long term success and replication in other communities. Often DVR also funds contracts for the
  Community Rehab Provider for current sites. Highly invested program.

# What is the Universal Changing Spaces Assistance Fund?

\$250K request to support accessible adult changing spaces statewide

- •Funded by: \$250K MHTARR
- Offers matching grants to:
  - **90/10** Small nonprofits
  - **80/20** Large nonprofits & small governments
  - 60/40 Small businesses
- •Supports access, dignity, and independence for people with disabilities
- Complements proposed HB141 for public accessibility


