## Recreate on Trust Lands!







Permits are necessary and available online for all non-commercial, recreational activities on Trust land that include:

- Overnight recreational use (such as camping)
- Motorized use (max. curb weight of 1,500 lbs.)
- Firewood harvest
- Subsistence trapping access
- Aircraft landing

You do NOT need a permit if your non-commercial, non-motorized, recreational use of Trust land is day use only. Activity must be in compliance with applicable state, federal, and local laws.

## **HOW TO OBTAIN A PERMIT**

Purchasing a general permit is quick and easy! You can have your permit in-hand immediately following your purchase. To get yours, visit: alaskamentalhealthtrust.org/landpermits

- Purchase multiple permits at once
- General permits available for daily, weekly, monthly, or yearly segments - prices start at \$10 and vary per duration of use
- Permits are available year-round
