## Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority

The Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority (Trust) is a state corporation that administers the Alaska Mental Health Trust, a perpetual trust, to improve the lives of beneficiaries. Beneficiaries include Alaskans who experience mental illness, substance use disorders, developmental disabilities, Alzheimer's Disease or related dementia, and traumatic brain injuries.

Each fiscal year, trustees approve funding for grants to beneficiaries, nonprofit organizations, service providers, tribal entities, state and local government agencies, and other groups that serve Trust beneficiaries. ## COVID-19 Response Grants

**\$1,334,724**

Launched in spring 2020, the Trust's COVID-19 response grant program provided organizations up to \$25,000 for assistance for emergent beneficiary needs, identified health and safety issues, and operational assistance. Trust COVID-19 response grants allowed for the purchase of supplies such as PPE, and tablets/computers to help clients stay connected to their service providers virtually, and to help ensure Trust beneficiaries had access to safety net services that kept them housed, fed, safe, and able to continue to access essential supports and services such as mental health and substance use treatment.
