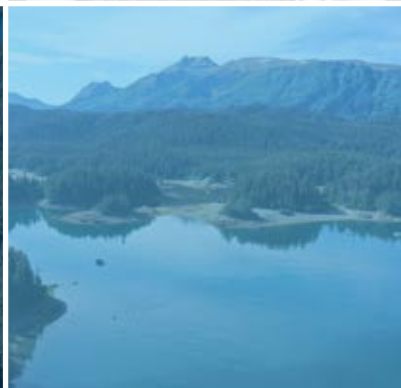


# 2024 Grant Investment Report





The Alaska Mental Health Trust Authority (Trust) is a state corporation that administers the Alaska Mental Health Trust, a perpetual trust, to improve the lives of beneficiaries. Beneficiaries include Alaskans who experience mental illness, substance use disorders, intellectual and developmental disabilities, Alzheimer’s disease and related dementia, and traumatic brain injuries.

Each fiscal year (FY), trustees approve funding for grants to beneficiaries, nonprofit organizations, service providers, Tribal entities, state and local government agencies, and other groups that serve Trust beneficiaries. 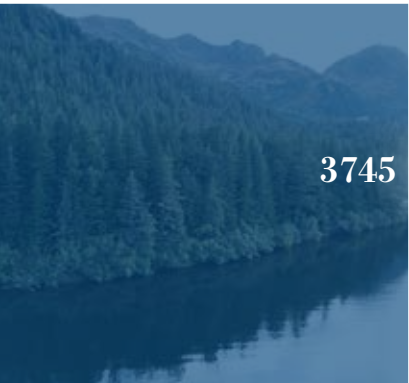
